We have a service called **Street Law**.

This is legal help that



 gives you help if you are homeless.
Homeless means you do not have a place to live.

#### is confidential.

This means we will not tell anyone

- your name
- what you talk about

unless you want us to.



We can also help if you might become homeless.



## How we can help

Some of the things we can help with are

- problems with housing
- problems at work
- problems with a shop
- money you owe
- if you have been the victim of a crime
- problems with **Centrelink**.

This is money you get from the government.

### • fines.

This is money you pay when you break a rule.

### • minor crimes.

This is a small thing you have done wrong. For example, driving with **no** licence.

• talk to other people for you



- help you if you need to go to court
- help with your problems



• get other people to help you



explain your rights to you.
