The Plan has 5 areas.



1. We will help people with disability understand the justice system

Justice means you are treated

• fair



• right by the law.



The justice system is the people and services that make sure the law is fair to everyone.

The justice system includes

lawyers



• the police



• the court.



We will try to make sure that

• our documents are easy to understand



• what we write on social media is easy to understand.

We will make sure that organisationsunderstand how we can helppeople with disability

- parents of people with disability



• guardians of people with disability.

A guardian is someone who

• is **not** your parent



 can help you make decisions or make decisions for you.





2. We will make sure our staff know about disability

We will make sure our staff

- know how to help people with disability
- know about the ACT Disability
 Justice Strategy.

The ACT Disability Justice Strategy is a plan for how the Australian Capital Territory will make sure people with disability



• are treated fairly



• can get a job if they want



• can be part of their community.

3. We will better understand people who use the justice system

We will

- ask people with disability about their access needs
- make sure our staff are trained to understand access needs
- meet the access needs of people with disability.

Access needs are things that

- help people with disability get into a place
- help people with disability understand information in ways that work for them.

We will tell people with disability where they can go if there are things we **cannot** help them with.











4. We will make it easier for people with disability to be part of our work

We will ask people with disability for **feedback**.

Feedback is when you tell us

• what you think we do well



• what you think we could do better.



We will

 support our staff who have disability to do their work



 make a list of organisations that help people with disability



 ask organisations who help people with disability to work with us as much as they can.



We will look at how we ask you about your access needs.

5. We will always try to do better



We might ask you about your access needs

• in a phone call



• in an email.



We will also

 tell decision makers what needs to change for people with disability



 know how many people with disability need our support.



When we start a new project we will ask people with disability for their ideas.



We will **evaluate** the Plan.



Evaluate means we will

• think about the parts of the Plan we like



 think about the parts of the Plan we do not like



 decide what we will do better in the next Plan.
